Noverant Adds TSA Training To Its Free Library

One of Noverant's core values is to promote safety and security in the aviation industry, including providing free training modules in order to support the cause. Toward that end, Noverant announced this month the addition of TSA-compliant Initial and Recurrent Training modules to its free library. These training modules, and the approved electronic documentation storage, are available to any registered user at no cost.

The Initial Security training is a direct link to the TSA online-course, the recurrent training is an approved training module (Recurrent Security Awareness Training – RSAT) developed by Noverant. Both include online e-signature and meet the TSA requirements.

TSA Amends Recurrent Training Deadlines

In an effort to simplify coordination of recurrent training, TSA modified the requirement for recurrent training expirations. Specifically, as of June 8, 2007, an individual can now complete his/her recurrent training in the month before or after the actual due date. Note that the NATV system will automatically remind/assign your recurrent training 30 days prior to its due date, and so as long as you complete the training per NATV, you will be in compliance (with a month to spare).

Do You Need To Keep Hardcopy Documentation Of The Training?

No! In addition to its simplicity, another major benefit of NATV is that hardcopy documentation is not required. Noverant explicitly checked with TSA headquarters, and they have approved electronic record keeping. So you are not required to maintain hardcopies of your training as long as it is provided via an approved electronic record-keeping system. (Note that NATV meets strict 21CFR11 guidelines for electronic documentation and e-signature). In the event of a TSA or FAA audit, you would login to NATV (from anywhere) and demonstrate compliance from your online transcript, or simply print it out to bring to a meeting. As good business practice, we still encourage users to periodically print or download a Noverant-certified PDF transcript that documents all actual training.
